MILITARY CREDIT

You may be able to earn undergraduate credits associated with military service. Joint Service Transcripts (JSTs) must be submitted to the Office of Admissions for an official evaluation, and active military personnel can have their current primary military occupational specialty (MOS) evaluated by submitting a positive performance evaluation dated within the last year.



OFFICE OF VETERAN AFFAIRS

K-State's Office of Veteran Affairs certifies the enrollments of students utilizing their VA educational benefits to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

You must submit an Enrollment Certification Request form to K-State's Office of Veteran Affairs for each semester or class you want certified to the VA.

We recommend that you apply for benefits at vets.gov as soon as possible, preferably three to six months prior to the start of your first semester.

Why is accreditation important?

Reputable, trusted accreditation validates the quality of an institution as a whole, offering evaluated measurements of everything, including academic offerings, governance, administration, mission, finances and resources.

K-State is a comprehensive, research, public land-grant institution that was founded in 1863. Continuing education at Kansas State University originated through the Kansas Cooperative Extension Service, which was tasked with extending the university to the people. Out of our Extension roots, the Kansas Board of Regents established the K-State Division of Continuing Education in 1966, later renamed K-State Global Campus. K-State Global Campus serves as the administrative home for K-State Online.

DIFFERENT FORMAT. SAME DIPLOMA.

Whether you earn a degree online or on campus, you'll receive the same diploma when you graduate, with no indication of how your courses were delivered. Signed by the university president and provost and stamped with the university seal, your diploma is more than just a piece of paper – it's a symbol of your hard work and persistence.

TUITION AND FEES

K-State Online provides affordable, accessible educational opportunities to meet the needs of students and professionals. Online and off-campus courses are assessed at a fixed tuition rate regardless of residency status. There are no nonresident fees for online and off-campus courses offered through K-State Online. Tuition rates vary by course level – undergraduate or graduate.

Additional fees may be assessed by colleges and departments.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND SCHOLARSHIPS

K-State has a number of scholarships for online students based on grade point average, financial need, military status, degree program or current employer. Even if you don't receive a scholarship, you still may be eligible for student financial aid.

To be eligible for financial assistance or scholarships, complete the following steps:

1. Apply for admission to Kansas State University. Degree-seeking students admitted to a bachelor's, master's or doctoral program are eligible for financial assistance.

2. Apply for federal financial aid. Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid, FAFSA. By submitting the FAFSA, you can apply for federal forms of student aid such as grants and loans.

UNWAVERING TOOLS AND SUPPORT.

RESOURCES AND SERVICES FOR ONLINE STUDENTS

Many services on campus in Manhattan, Kansas, are available to online students:

Academic Coaching: Academic coaches meet with students to help answer questions and create an individualized strategy for success.

Career Center: Find training resources, career advising and employment connections to prepare for the workforce.

K-State Libraries: Online students can locate research materials and resources online, as well as chat live with a librarian.

LGBT Resource Center: Find information and resources for those of differing sexualities and gender identities, including resources on non-discrimination and counseling.

Powercat Financial and CashCourse: Schedule a free, online, confidential financial counseling appointment to manage your money and student loans.

Stress Management Resources: Counseling Services at K-State provides links to online tools and resources for online students.

Student Access Center: Arrange for academic accommodations and support you may need during your course.

Tutoring: The Academic Achievement Center provides online tutoring via videoconference.

Writing Center: Make an appointment to learn writing strategies and receive feedback through online consultations with experienced writing tutors.

PUSH THE ENVELOPE.

K-State Online offers many opportunities for you to meet your graduation date faster.

INTERSESSION

Intersession is a time between standard university semesters when you can complete an entire course in one to three weeks. Intersession is offered every January, May and August, with courses available in a variety of departments. You can take classes online, on campus or as part of a field trip or study abroad opportunity.

EIGHT-WEEK COURSES

TRANSFER CREDITS

K-State accepts transfer credits from accredited universities. Once you are accepted to K-State, we will work with you to evaluate your transcripts and determine which credits will transfer.

PROCTORING FEES

Some courses may require you to take proctored exams. These are exams taken online or on paper that must be taken in the presence of a proctor to ensure academic integrity. This is common practice for online programs to meet accreditation requirements.

Most proctor services require students to pay a fee, and it is recommended that you ask about fees when searching for your proctor. If your course includes exams that require a proctor, you will be contacted by the Student Success and Advising Office prior to the start of the semester.

FINDING AN EXAM PROCTOR

Some courses require a proctor for exams, while others do not. Check for an email from the Student Success and Advising Office once you enroll in a course to determine if you are required to find a proctor.
